From Atlanta, take I-20 west (towards Six Flags) to Thornton Road (Exit 44). Turn right on Thornton and go 1.5 miles to Maxham Road. Turn right on Maxham. At the second traffic light, turn right on Old Alabama Road. The school is 2.5 miles on the right.

**Additional Instructions**

Dance and Theatre auditions run the full day, from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

**For students nominated in Theatre (Design ONLY):** The Assigned Script review for the 2014 GHP State-Level Interview in Theatre Design is *A Midsummer's Night Dream*.

**For students nominated in Dance:** There has been a change to the dance audition process: this year, the dance knowledge test will *not* be administered at the state level auditions. There has also been a change in interview times. Please speak to your GHP District Coordinator about the change. NOTE: There will be morning, midday, and afternoon auditions. Audition times are assigned to candidates considering distance and convenience as much as possible. **BE PROMPT!**

At the GHP Dance auditions, you will:

1. Show evidence of **technical dance ability**. Dance educators will conduct a ballet warm-up followed by three combinations in ballet, modern dance, and jazz. You are to dress in leotards and stirrup or footless tights. Bring ballet shoes and jazz shoes. This technical dance ability will be in groupings of 30 students at a time.
2. Be prepared to perform a choreographed piece of one minute in either ballet, modern or jazz. **NO TAP!** You must furnish the music on CD or mp3 player. A CD player will be provided. Judgment will be based on the performance, not the choreography. This one-minute piece should include two types of turns and two types of leaps. **It should not include props, costumes, gymnastic stunts, or singing.**
3. Answer carefully prepared questions presented by the interviewers to determine your interests, work habits, career plans, and knowledge of dance. **You do not need to change clothes for the interview.**
