Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program End of School Year Report 2022-2023 School Year

For the Georgia General Assembly per O.C.G.A. § 20-2-2118

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Executive Summary

Senate Bill 10 as signed into law on May 18, 2007, created the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship (GSNS) Program which allows parents of eligible special needs students to transfer their children to another public school, public school system, state school, or approved participating private school. On July 1, 2021, OCGA § 20-2-2114 was further amended to qualify students who received Pre-Kindergarten special education services and students with Section 504 plans with eligible conditions.

This report represents information on the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year, as required by O.C.G.A. § 20-2-2118, which stipulates that the Governor's Office of Student Achievement, in conjunction with the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE), shall provide the General Assembly with a report regarding the scholarship program for the previous fiscal year. This was the sixteenth school year the GSNS Program was administered.

2022-2023 Program Highlights

- Total number of students that transferred to another school within their assigned school system or to a school in another school system through the provisions of OCGA § 20-2-2113 was **72.**
- Total student participation in the program for the 2022-2023 school year was 5,864 students. This was an increase of 76 students from the previous school year.
- There were 281 total private schools approved to participate in the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship. Twenty-one of those schools were approved for the first time during the 2022-2023 school year. Fifteen of those 21 schools had scholarship students enrolled during the 2022-2023 school year.
- The average number of students enrolled in each participating private school was **21**.










2022-2023 School Year – GSNS Special Education Student Participation by Primary Area of Exceptionality






