Overview

This memorandum offers an analysis of the 2024 Beating the Odds (BTO) designations. Schools can earn designations of “Beating the Odds” (BTO), “Within Expected Range” (WER), or “Below Expected Range” (BER) based on their College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) and school characteristics. The analysis compares schools’ performance with schools possessing similar characteristics across the state. Schools that perform higher than similar schools are considered “Beating the Odds.” It is important to note that schools that “Beat the Odds” may still have low CCRPI scores and/or gaps in performance.

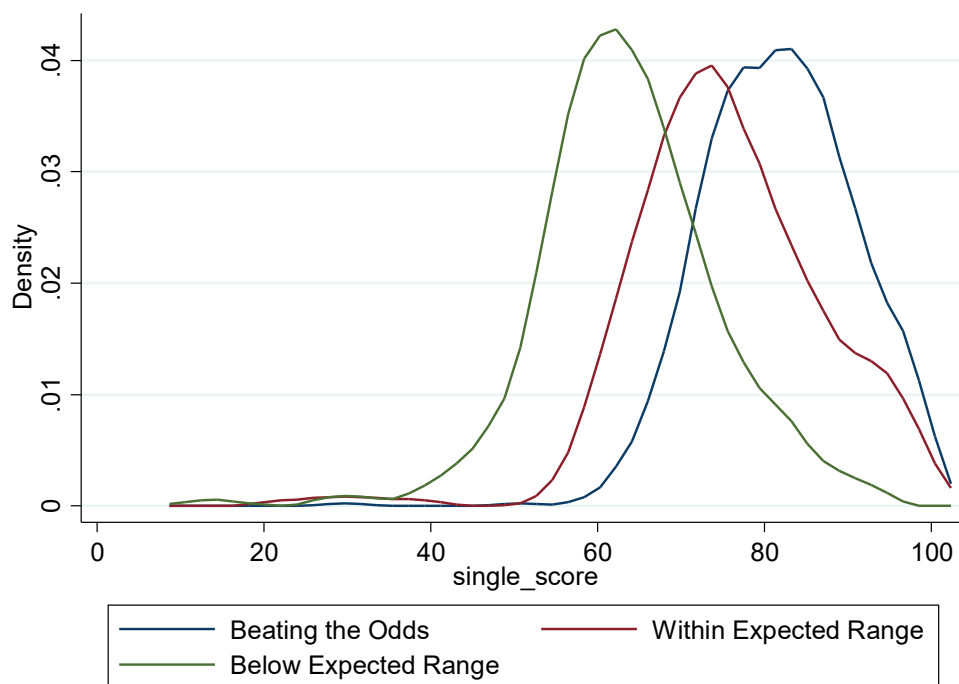
- Percentage of economically disadvantaged students,
- Percentage of English language learners,
- Percentage of students with disabilities,
- Percentage of students in each race/ethnicity,
- Percentage of female students,
- Student mobility,
- School size,
- Whether a school is defined as non-traditional, and
- School type (elementary, middle, high, and schools that span grade clusters).

CCRPI Single Score

- The mean 2024 CCRPI Single Scores for each designation are:
 - **81.8** for “Beating the Odds,”
 - **75.4** for “Within Expected Range,” and
 - **63.6** for “Below Expected Range.”
- Schools with higher CCRPI Single Scores are more likely to achieve a designation of “Beating the Odds.”

School Characteristics

- The distribution of schools earning each BTO designation is similar in 2024, 2023, and 2019, with slightly more schools earning a “Beating the Odds” designation in 2024.

- The distributions of BTO designations across schools with different grade clusters are relatively even. Elementary schools have the highest percentage of schools “Beating the Odds,” while high schools have the highest percentage of schools “Below Expected Range.”

- In 2024, 67 (37.2%) districts had a higher proportion of schools designated as “Beating the Odds” than in 2023.

 - 24 schools (47.1%) earned a designation of “Below Expected Range.”
