



# **Learning Walk Data**

Each standard is based on a rubric ranging from Level I to Level IV using "Look Fors" that include the best practices of Personalized Learning. Teachers with two or more years with PL Grant, on average, are excelling compared to teachers with one year. The goal is growth by the end of the year with new and veteran grant teachers attaining Level III on the rubric or at least moving up one level and/or improved commentary from observers.



# Teacher and Leader Feedback on Personalized Learning

"I have experienced a positive change in behavior. I feel this is a direct result of offering personalized learning to each student. This cuts down on their frustration level and builds their confidence level by working on their individual level on assignments. My students feel more a ease on taking academic risks." 


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# Dreambox Online Math Learning Data


In first the semester of FY 20, the average growth made by students using Dreambox is **9.3%** with growth ranging from K to 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

## **Lexia Core 5 Reading Data FY 19**

In SY 18-19, PL grant student growth on Lexia Core 5 grew from 13% on or above level to 64%, a 392% increase by the end of the year.

## **Lexia Core 5 Reading Data FY 20**
