



Governor's Honors Program Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can a student bring (and wear) bathing suits?

Only students participating in the fitness minors will have scheduled opportunities to swim. Swimsuits should be appropriate for a state-sponsored academic program. The program administrators and staff reserve the right to require students to modify any clothing that is deemed inappropriate.

2. Can a student choose to train (i.e., run, jog, swim) individually in the early morning or late evening?

The safety of our students is paramount to the program. Students are not allowed to participate in early morning/late evening activities without proper supervision.

3. Where can a student find the finalist forms?

4. How will I be assigned a dorm/roommate?

GOSA program staff will email a roommate preference survey in late April/early May to all 2014 GHP finalists. Roommates and dorm assignments will be made by GOSA program staff and will be posted on the GHP webpage for students in late May.

5. What is the day permission form that is mentioned in the GHP handbook?

Students are required to remain on campus for the entire program. However, students may leave campus on a limited basis only with a parent, guardian, or approved adult (21 years of age or older) specified by name on the Day Permission Form. The Day Permission form will be posted on the GHP website in late May/early June.

6. Is it okay if I am one day late? Need to leave 2 days early?

Given the intensity of experience in a four week program, we cannot accept students who cannot attend the entire time.

7. What do I do if I get an error message on the FAF?

8. What are the clothing requirements for the summer?

All clothing must be appropriate. Casual clothing may include pants, jeans without significant tearing, skirts, and comfortable shoes. Casual dresses, sundresses, and shorts are allowed but must be appropriate in length (no strapless dresses). Dress clothes should be something that the student would wear to church, an internship, a job interview, or another special occasion like a graduation ceremony.
