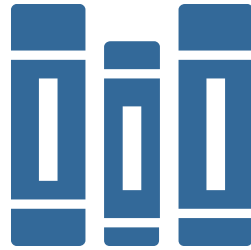

Growing Readers is a K-3 literacy professional learning grant that provides consistent and high-quality professional learning to teachers on effective reading instruction to help more children read at grade level by the end of third grade. Growing Readers Specialists also coach school-based Candidates on effective coaching in an effort to impact more teachers and students.

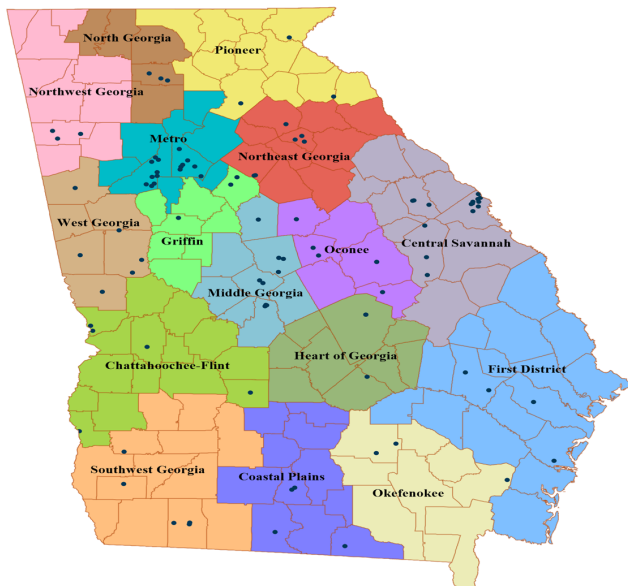

After the second Professional Learning Session, over 93% of participants felt that they learned useful literacy intervention strategies, felt confident in supporting Tier 2 and 3 students, and are prepared to implement strategies in the classroom.

After the second Regional Meeting, over 92% of candidates felt that they felt confident scoring teacher-student conferences and working towards personal learning goals.
