Executive Summary

Senate Bill 10 as signed into law on May 18, 2007, created the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship (GSNS) Program which allows parents of eligible special needs students to transfer their children to another public school, public school system, state school, or approved participating private school. On July 1, 2021, OCGA § 20-2-2114 was further amended so that students with 504 plans for certain conditions are eligible to participate.

This report represents the results for the 2021-2022 school year as required by O.C.G.A. § 20-2-2118, which stipulates that the Governor's Office of Student Achievement, in conjunction with the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) shall provide the General Assembly with a report regarding the scholarship program for the previous fiscal year. This was the fifteenth school year the GSNS Program was administered.

2021-2022 Program Highlights

- Total student participation in the program increased from the previous school year by **485** with **5,788 total GSNS** students enrolled in private schools.
- The number of participating private schools increased by **18** with **273** total participating schools.
- **22** was the average number of students enrolled in a participating private school.
- Of the **5,788** students enrolled, program entry was through a(n):
 - Individualized Education Plan (IEP): 5,544
 - 504 Plan: 214
 - Kindergarten, via receipt of Pre-K Special Education services: 30
- Participating student demographics are
 - o **32%** Female, **68%** Male
 - **30.39%** Black, **54.18%** White, and **15.43%** Asian/Hispanic/Native American/Multi-Racial.
- \$38,140,099 was paid in fiscal year 2022 for scholarships to students.
- \$6,590 was the average annual scholarship amount for students.
