Innovation Fund Foundation Grant Program Demographics and Quick Facts

The Innovation Fund Foundation (IFF) invests in innovative partnerships and initiatives to ignite student achievement across Georgia. IFF aspires to be the state’s model for creating lasting impacts on education through collaboration and innovation. To date, IFF has launched three competitive grant programs.

Community Partnership Grant Program provided funding to local education agency (LEA) school districts, traditional public schools, charter schools, and 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations to advance student achievement in Georgia.

COVID-19 Response Fund Grant provided traditional and public schools, charter schools, and school districts up to \$10,000 to implement programs that mitigate the long-term impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Innovation Summit Pilot Grant Program provided eligible organizations that attended the 2018 and 2019 Innovation Summit between \$1,000-\$7,000 to pilot an idea that targets the root cause of a complex challenge they were facing.


