<b>Budget</b> (15 points)	The budget is <b>specific and</b> <b>reasonable</b> and all items <b>strongly align</b> with the described grant project. ( <i>12-15 points</i> )	The budget is <b>mostly specific and</b> <b>reasonable</b> and the items <b>align</b> with the described grant project. (8-11 points)	The budget is <b>somewhat specific</b> <b>and reasonable</b> and the items <b>somewhat align</b> with the described grant project. ( <i>4-7 points</i> )	The budget is <b>not specific and</b> <b>reasonable</b> and the items <b>do not</b> <b>align</b> with the described grant project. (0-3 points)
