K12 Student Discipline Dashboard – User Guide

Data Source - GA Awards

- K12 Data are provided by GADOE from GADOE Student Record Data Collection. These data are processed and updated annually for this application in March.
- Data Aggregates: Data are aggregated at School Level. Schools with number of disciplined students less than 10 are excluded.
 - School Counts A student is counted uniquely within each school they attended. For example, if a student attends multiple schools in a school year, they will be counted multiple times.
 - District Level All school counts within a district and school year are rolled up into district level.
 - o State Level All schools counts within a school year are rolled up into district level.

School Characteristics Display

- When multiple schools are selected, some of the school characteristics may not be displayed. They are NOT displayed especially when the selected schools have different attribute values. This is true for Climate Star ratings, PBIS Recommendation and Grades Served attributes.
- School Climate star ratings, PBIS Recommendation and Grades Served reflect school level data and are not applied at the district level.

Key Performance Indicators (Metrics)

Enrollment: "All Students Enrolled" count by data selections made (year/state/district/state). Data Source is GADOE Student Record Data Collection.

Students with Incidents: Number of Students who were involved in at least one disciplinary incident in a school year. Please refer to "Appendix- A" on page 4 of this document for the disciplinary incident type descriptions.

Total Incidents: Total number of disciplinary incidents within a school year.

In-School Suspension Rate: Percent of students receiving In-School Suspensions (ISS) within a school year. ISS – Temporary removal of a student from his or her regular classroom(s) for at least half a day. Student remains under direct supervision of school personnel.

Out-of-School Suspension Rate: Percent of students receiving Out-of-School Suspensions within a school year.

Expulsion Rate - Percent of students expelled within a school year.

NOTE: Please note this application EXCLUDES all schools with disciplinary incidents less than 10 at a school in a school year. These schools are NOT included in district and/or state level counts

Percentage of Disciplinary Incident Occurrences

This chart displays percentage of disciplinary incident occurrence by selected subgroups. These percent's are sorted by descending order. Students included in the chart are all involved in one or more disciplinary incidents.

Percentage of Population vs. Overall Population

This chart compares percent's by subgroups; of overall population enrolled verses the population involved in one or more disciplinary incidents. Percent's are sorted in descending order.

Discipline Consequences

This chart displays percent of students by subgroup and by disciplinary action taken for the disciplinary incidents.

Incident-to-Action Flow Chart

This "sankey chart" neatly depicts how each discipline incident type leads to school actions in response, split out by gender and race/ethnicity. The width of the data links depicts the number of incident occurrence.

Colored vertical bars (nodes) and flows (links) allow user to drill deeper. By clicking a node or a link user can drill down; and by clicking again data view is restored.

User "Selections" made are neatly displayed at the bottom of this chart.

Subgroups (Checkbox): This selection allows user to view dashboard by a selected subgroup. Subgroups include disability status, economic status, English learners, grade levels, gender and race-ethnicity. When no selections are made, all subgroups are displayed. By default "Gender" subgroup is selected.



Clear Selections Button – Clears ALL application selections and/or filters.

Filters - School Year / School District / School

Make Selection

- 1. Type or click on the selections (item(s) of choice) and then click on the green check symbol.
- 2. Or click on the selection (item(s) of choice) and then click on the next selection or anywhere outside.
- 3. Or click on the magnifying glass and type your choice



Remove Selection

- o Click on the selected choice item(s) and then click on the "RED X" to remove selection.
- o Or click on the selected choice and click anywhere outside to remove selection.
- o Or click on the magnifying glass and click on clear selection to remove all selections

NOTE: Please note this application will allow you to select "POSSIBLE" selections ONLY, they are color coded.


Dark grey indicates excluded selections.

White indicates included by default but are NOT selected.

Light grey indicates possible selections.

Green indicates selection has been made.

Example: If a school opened in 2015, 2014 will be **DARK GREY** for this school. Also only one district and schools years 2015,2016,2017 are already included, so are **WHITE**. Other schools in this school district are **LIGHT GREY**, indicating they are possible selections.
