2020 Music: Woodwind Audition Preparation

All semifinalists in Music will participate in an individual interview **after** their auditions. Students should anticipate being on-site for at least 90 minutes. It is strongly recommended that students consult an instructor prior making a final choice of repertoire.

****PLEASE NOTE: Use of accompaniment is not required, and is not a part of the audition score; however, some students may choose to perform with accompaniment when appropriate. We cannot guarantee that pianos will be tuned appropriately, and we will not provide an MP3 player or CD player. Students choosing to perform to a prerecorded accompaniment should bring their own playback equipment.***

Woodwind Semifinalists:

Semifinalists should be prepared to perform a short selection from a single movement of a solo piece from the standard repertoire not to exceed two (2) minutes. A movement of a concerto or sonata is preferred. It is not required to start at the beginning of the piece. Please choose a selection that best represents your abilities. Each student will be given two (2) short excerpts to sight-read that will be provided by the interviewer. The student will have thirty (30) seconds to review the etude prior to performance.
