

# College & Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

The CCRPI is an accountability tool that measures school, district, and state progress in preparing students for the next step in their education or career. Components are weighted differently for elementary (K-5), middle (6-8), and high (9-12) school grade bands.

## Content Mastery



30%

for all grade bands

Content Mastery measures whether students are achieving at the level necessary for the next grade, college, or career.

Component includes:

- Achievement in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies on the Georgia Milestones Assessments and Georgia Alternate Assessment

## Progress

Progress measures how much growth students are demonstrating relative to academically similar students.

Component includes:

- Student Growth Percentiles measuring progress in English Language Arts and Mathematics
- Progress towards English language proficiency for English Learners measured by the ACCESS assessment

## Closing Gaps

Closing Gaps measures whether all students and all subgroups are making improvements in achievement rates.

Component includes:

- Progress towards improvement targets for all students
- Progress towards improvement targets for racial subgroups, English Learners, students with disabilities, and economically disadvantaged students

## Readiness

Readiness measures whether students are demonstrating preparedness for the next grade, college, or career.

Component includes:

- Literacy
- Student attendance
- Beyond the Core (courses in fine arts, world languages, physical education, health, careers)

9-12 only:

- Accelerated enrollment
- Pathway completion
- College and career readiness

## Graduation Rate

Graduation Rate measures whether students are graduating with a regular diploma in four or five years.

Component includes:

- Four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate
- Five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate

Each component is calculated on a scale of 0-100.

The overall CCRPI score is a weighted average of all components on a scale of 0-100.
