**Awards were revised on January 23, 2015 to account for a rubric scoring error that affected 13 applicants. Using the original scoring methodology, the adjusted score only resulted in award adjustments for 4 applicants. Of these, one additional grantee (Georgia School for the Deaf) received a grant award, and the remaining three grantees received increased award amounts (Douglas, Randolph, and Worth). All 13 applicants were notified of the scoring adjustment.*
