High-Need, Rural School District List

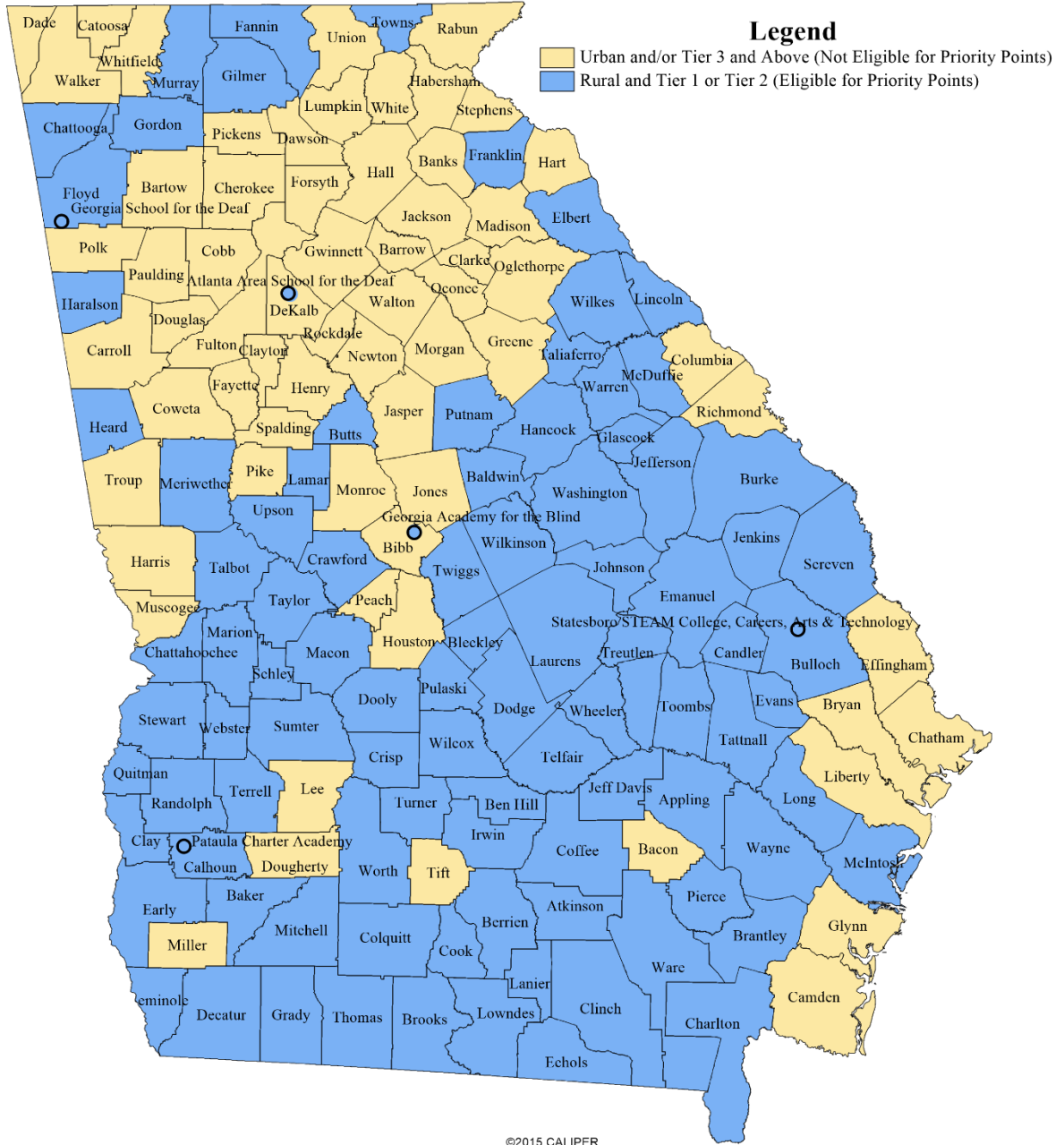
Applicants that classify as high-need, rural school districts or are schools located within high-need, rural school districts are eligible to receive three priority points on their Community Partnership Grant application. Please see below for the definition and list of high-need, rural school districts.

High-Need: LEAs located in counties designated as Tier 1 or Tier 2 based on the Georgia Department of Community Affairs' annual job tax credit tiers are considered high-need. These counties represent the counties with high unemployment rates, low per capita incomes, and high percentages of residents whose incomes are below the state poverty level.

Rural: LEAs are considered rural for the purposes of this grant if they serve fewer than 25 students per square mile.

****Note:** *The three State Schools are also eligible for priority points. In addition, state charter schools that are located in a Tier 1 or Tier 2 County and have an attendance zone in which all LEAs are eligible for priority points are also eligible for priority points. The below map highlights the LEAs that are eligible for priority points. Please note, schools located within these LEAs are also eligible for priority points. A list of LEAs is also included below.*
