- 1. Describe the team that will participate in the Accelerator? (500 words). In your answer:
 - a. Provide evidence that the school or district-level leader chosen to participate in the accelerator has actual decision-making power;

b. Describe each individual's role/experience within the school or and why each individual was selected to be on the Accelerator team.

- 4. Answer **ONE** of the below questions. Please support your answer with data and examples. (500 words)
 - a. In 2016, 35.1% of Georgia's 3rd graders scored proficient or above on the Georgia Milestones reading assessment. Why?
 - b. In 2016, Georgia's four-year graduation rate was 79.4%. Why?
- 5. What's the most helpful piece of <u>critical</u> feedback you did not agree with that you have received from a student or students. Why? How did you respond to this feedback? (500 words)
